Famously Infamous

The Bible says, “Come, let us build ourselves a city and a tower with its top in the heavens, and let us make a name for ourselves, lest we be dispersed over the face of the whole earth” (**Genesis 11:4**). Do you want to be famous? Do you want to be well known for something? What is your primary motivating factor in that desire? Is it worth examination?

We have to remember that sin entered the world through Adam and Eve’s pride in the garden. Their disregard for God’s single law prepared the way for Cain’s murdering Able, and the cycle of sinful violence that followed. The flood was sent to wipe the slate clean because human-kind had rapidly declined to only a single righteous family. Keep in mind that the propensity to sin remained within even the most righteous people, Noah and his sons. So, the same tendency resurfaced immediately after the floodwaters dissipated. Noah’s descendants, with unified language, are the ones looking to make a name for themselves many years later. We can’t assume that their internal motivations were any better than mine or yours, and we should acknowledge that they could have been worse. Knowing the character of God exhibited in the rest of scripture indicates He wasn’t simply taunting them, messing with their minds, for fun and games! Though they may have innocently wanted to be known for accomplishing a great feat, He knew their hearts could and eventually would lead them astray without His intervention.

Humans have built many “tall towers” since that time, while speaking many languages. We have also seen that God’s concern was warranted. Think of the horrible atrocities human-kind has “accomplished” over the centuries. When we “are one people” we can do amazing things, positive or negative, good or evil (**Genesis 11:6**).

Just imagine what we could do if we were united under God’s purpose! What could we accomplish with His goals in mind? What if we were famous for being people of Christ, with unique love and unity? (**John 13:34-35; Ephesians 4:1-6**)

We have a choice to make each day: to be famous for Jesus or infamous for ourselves (**Matthew 6:1**). We must have regard for God’s laws, no matter how strange they may seem in our time. We’re not here to make a name for ourselves, we’re here to make ourselves for His name!
