## **Even More Lettuce!**

Maybe you think you've had all the exhortation you can take? The Hebrew author actually has more to say. These Hortatory Subjunctive word formations in the original Greek of the New testament are challenging us to greater boldness in the journey with Christ. Are you ready to take on these challenges together?

**Let us run with endurance (Hebrews 12:1).** Another shared characteristic of the hall of faith is running with endurance. They realized it was going to be a long race so they disciplined their minds and hearts to handle the pace of the race. The prime example of self-discipline in the next few verses is Christ himself!

**Let us show gratitude (Hebrews 12:28).** When I make strides in spiritual development and look back on how I got there, I find faces of friends, and family looking back at me. Show gratitude to those who help you grow; they aren't finished growing, so our thankfulness can give them a boost of satisfaction. Don't forget to thank God who sent you those helpers. David said it best when responding to Goliath's taunting: "the battle is the Lord's" (**1 Samuel 17:47**).

**Let us go outside the camp (Hebrews 13:13).** Jesus went through a sacrificial situation similar to the two goats on the Day of Atonement. He was both the bearer of punishment and the scapegoat who carried the sins of the people outside the camp. Now we must "go outside the camp" with Him so people will know we are His disciples (**John 13:34-35**). We must live in this world but align ourselves with Christ in an obvious way. We'll bear the same reproach He endured, His Cross.

**Let us praise God (Hebrews 13:14-15).** Fortunately, Christ's story doesn't end there. We're seeking to be reunited with him in the "city which is to come," a lasting city, the New Jerusalem. That's why we offer sacrifices of praise to God and give thanks to Him. That's why we will not grow weary in doing good to all people (**Galatians 6:9-10**). That's why we share our lives and wealth with others. Why? To please God our Father. I exhort you to join me as we aim to please a God who loves like no other.
