Feed The Children

... but Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven." Matthew 19:13-14

Several years ago, a church's leadership handed my father-in-law ten thousand dollars for feeding orphans in Zimbabwe. Someone had told them about children who were suffering and dying because they couldn't afford to buy what food was available, and they hardly hesitated before deciding to do what they could to help. Hearing about this brought a huge lump to my throat!

Children touch our hearts simply by being themselves. Their joys and their plights are easily felt by all of us because they haven't learned the adult technique of disguising feelings and needs. And most of us recognize easily that children are dependent on someone else for many basic needs because, well, because God designed it that way. Even if they are twelve thousand miles away, normal adults feel responsible for providing what children's bodies need to survive and thrive.

Surely, we should feel the same obligation toward their souls. As bad as it is that children die from a lack of physical food, the greatest tragedy is that millions of them go through childhood and then adulthood with physical health and nourishment, only to die spiritually. Why? Well, in many cases, simply because one adult didn't provide the encouragement that would have easily drawn a child into a church environment where spiritual nourishment would be given. More tragically, it happens because some parent won't teach his or her own children at home about Jesus and his word, nor will they make it possible for that child to be in Bible classes and worship services so he or she could hear that message.

Let's bring them in and feed them!

Introduction: (1 John 2:15)

- The “World” is just such a temptress; she beckons and tempts us.
- Never is she committed to your good.
 - **Victory is Assured! (1 John 2:13-14)**
- Note two things:
 1. The word “overcome” – NIKE – “victory.”
 2. The tense of the verb (past completed action).
- This victory has already occurred! **(1 John 5:4; John 16:33; Revelation 12:11)**
 - **The Need for All People in God’s Family (1 John 2:12-14)**
- The NT commonly refers to Christians in terms of a family.
 - a) “Fathers” – A title of respect. **(Acts 7:2; 22:1; Matthew 23:9)**
 - b) “Children”, and “young men.” **(Revelation 2:4)**
- **Infatuation With the World (1 John 2:15-17)**
- Rivals for the Christian’s heart.
- No, this is not telling us to:
 - a) Be unloving and condemning towards the world.
 - b) Be unconcerned about the environment! **(Genesis 1:31)**
- The “world” refers to...? **(James 4:4; Ephesians 5:25-27).**
- The battle for our hearts and commitment is powerful and subtle.
 - **Our Downfall (1 John 2:16)**
 - a) *“The cravings of sinful man”* (NIV)
 - b) *“The lust of his eyes.”*
 - c) *“Pride in possessions.”*
- 5. A Bad Emotional Investment (1 John 2:17)**
 - She has come out especially for him... **(Proverbs 7:13-15).**
 - Apparently he’s not as special as she suggested... **(Proverbs 7:25-26)**
 - Don’t put your power and energies in “the world.” Come to Jesus instead.
 - He offers relationship and love that is deep, and fulfilling
