Text: (1 John 5:1-5)

1. Love the Father, Love the Child (1 John 5:1-2)

- Literally: “Everyone who loves him who *fathered* loves him who is *fathered*.”
- If we love the father, we must love his child as well.

2. Is Your Burden Heavy? (1 John 5:3)

- Love and obedience. No need to squirm (**John 14:15**).
- What is the greatest desire of a loving child? (**Mt. 11:28-30; 23:1-4**)
- Three ways in which God’s commands are not burdensome:
 - A. God provides strength to carry them out (**1 Corinthians 10:13**).
 - B. Love makes burdens lighter.
 - C. God’s commands aren’t burdens because there’s victory in Jesus!

3. Victory in Jesus (1 John 5:4-5)

A. “World” (1 Jn. 2:15-17)

B. “Faith” - FAITH IN WHAT? FAITH IN WHOM?

C. “Victory” (**John 12:31-33; 16:33**)

- There has been much to “overcome” in the last 150 years or so...
- Does the “World” have the upper hand?
- Is the message of the gentle Galilean muted and hushed?
- Children of God must understand that we can have Victory!
- John is so certain he puts it in the past tense...
