Pay Attention to Your Soul!

Your doctor probably runs routine lab work when he sees you for your annual physical. He's interested in things like your weight and your blood pressure to assess your general well-being.

Physical health has certain benchmarks. If your blood sugar is too high or too low, there's a problem. If your tests reveal results that are outside of normal tolerances, your doctor will consult with you to figure out how to deal with the problem.

Sometimes I wish our spiritual health could be quantified and charted. We could examine our holiness and see if it is trending up or down. We could be given a printout that shows that we have tested positive for anxiety, greed, pride, or any number of spiritual maladies that often go unnoticed.

Scripture has all sorts of descriptions of things that happen to Christians who are dying: they fall from grace (**Galatians 5:1-4**), they are led away by error (**2 Peter 3:17**), they become weak (**1 Corinthians 8:11**), they move away from hope (**Colossians 1:21-23**), they deny the Lord (**2 Peter 2:1**), and even depart from God (**Hebrews 3:12**).

Unfortunately, many of those who fall victim to these spiritual sicknesses never realize it until it is too late. The devil never brings it to our attention when we are heading down his road.

A wise person takes inventory of his or her spiritual health and well-being. How is yours?

Keeping True to the Covenant

Text: (**Exodus 20:14**)

1. Marriage Is A Covenant

- What do these verses tell us about a marriage? (**Genesis 2:18-24**)
- There are at least two relevant terms in this passage (**Malachi 2:13-16**).
 - Covenant – an agreement entered into solemnly by two people...
 - Faithless — repeated five times in six verses...

2. The Command About “Adultery” is All About “Marriage”

- God forbids adultery but He is really concerned with is marriage.
- Adultery is anything that violates the *marriage* covenant (**Matthew 5:27-28**).

3. Marriage, In Order to Work, Should Be Permanent

- No one is *completely* compatible with someone else.
- There are so many unknowns in our future, but in marriage there should be one given...
- After all, isn't this the commitment God makes toward us?

4. At the Heart of Marriage is Intimacy

- Paul recognizes that society offers “competition” (**1 Corinthians 7:1-5**).
- He also sees the antidote offered in marriage (**Hebrews 13:4; Proverbs 5:15-20**).

5. Don't Underestimate Its Power

- Humans have a remarkable sense of invulnerability; “It couldn't happen to me.”
- Notice that some had “deceived” themselves (**1 Corinthians 6:9-11**).
- Paul warns that this is delusional, but notice the second part of the passage: Forgiveness!

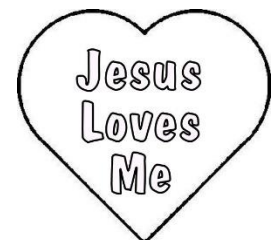
