The New Commandment

Text: (1 John 2:3-11)

Introduction: This passage is basically about two things:

- a) What we owe God (Obedience)
- b) What we owe each other (Love)

1. Obedience (1 John 2:3-6)

- Some who claim relationship with God felt obedience was unnecessary (**Mt. 7:21-23**).
- Notice the signs of relationship: (**John 14:15**)
 - a) Obedience.
 - b) Allowing God's love to become matured in you.
 - c) Walking as Jesus walked.

2. The New Commandment (1 John 2:7-8)

- A particularly Christian endearment and a favorite of John (**1 Jn. 3:2, 21; 4:1, 7**).
- In the church, have we lost the art of calling each other by terms of respect and love?
- Exactly how new was this commandment? (**Jn. 13:34-35; Lev. 19:18; Dt. 10:19**)
- The key lies in Jesus redefining love in the upper room: as I have loved you!

3. Loving Our Brethren (1 John 2:9-11)

- Too often we think of our Christian walk in negative terms – what we have not done.
- Positive action is required. What have we done? Have we loved? (**1 John 3:18**)
- Love is known by the action that it prompts! (**1 John 4:20**)
- We can't claim a vertical relationship (with God) until we can demonstrate a horizontal relationship (with each other).

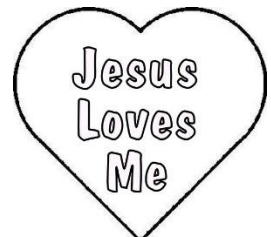
